

DecisionEdge: DecisionCharts for Microsoft Project Removing DecisionCharts entries from the Microsoft Project Menus

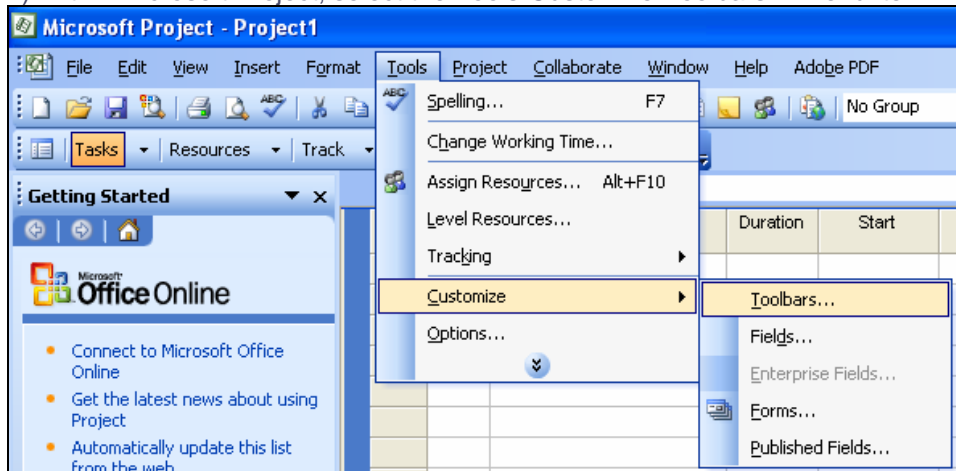
Problem: After uninstalling DecisionCharts for Microsoft Project, there are still a few DecisionCharts items remaining on the toolbar and on the Tools and Help menus in Microsoft Project. How do I remove them?

Solution: These menu items are normally removed during the DecisionCharts uninstall process. If they remain, you can manually remove them using the steps described in this document.

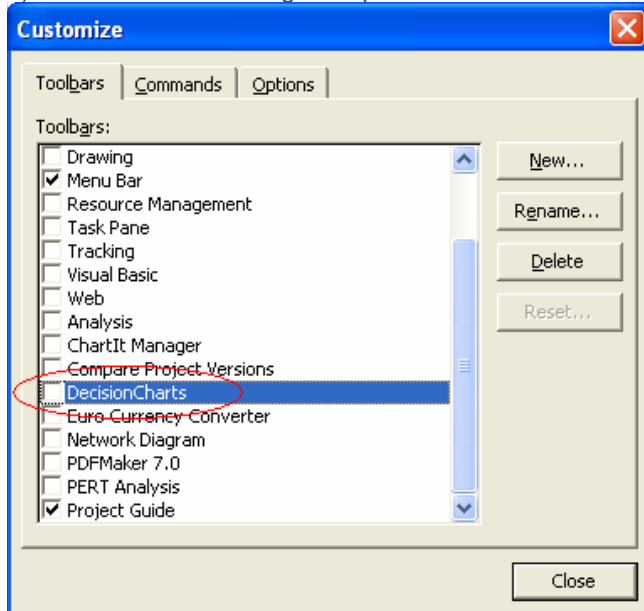
These instructions apply to the following items:

- DecisionCharts toolbar icon
- “DecisionCharts” entry on the Tools menu
- “DecisionCharts Help” entry on the Help menu

1) Within Microsoft Project, select the Tools-Customize-Toolbars... menu item



2) The Customize dialog will open. On the **Toolbars** tab, uncheck the “DecisionCharts” entry:



This will remove the DecisionCharts toolbar.

3) Now, with the Customize dialog still open, go to the Tools menu – drag the “DecisionCharts” item to the Customize dialog and drop it there. The DecisionCharts menu item will be removed from the Tools menu.

4) Repeat this process for the “DecisionCharts Help” entry on the Help menu.

All DecisionCharts entries are now removed from the Microsoft Project interface.
